## It all started with one. One classmate, friend, athlete, alumni...one loss

The story of the CEF Class Funds started with one unexpected death: Classmate and friend Denny Breibarth. Memories of Denny remained amongst the friends and CHS alumni. Soon, as the 1963 50th class reunion approached, many of the organizers decided to not only honor Denny but all of the fallen classmates of 1963 by establishing a "CHS Class of 1963 Memorial Fund" with the CEF.

Since that time, the CEF has three fully-funded, robust class funds that join the 25 other named endowed funds. These special class funds not only support educational opportunities for students of Cloquet, but keep classmates connected. To date, class funds generate thousands of dollars from the investment interest of the fund that go on to support programs and activities granted by the CEF.

To talk with Barry Bergquist, who was instrumental in communicating with his classmates about starting the 1963 fund, there is a sense of purpose, dedication, and nostalgia. He feels that by establishing a class fund Cloquet High School classes are "bridging generations by remembering and honoring the connections they made at Cloquet High School."

Stephen Mangan, class of 1964, couldn't agree more. He, among

others of '64, began to work toward establishing their own fund in memory of their lost classmates. "We had quite a few that passed away. We didn't want to lose sight of them." He went on to talk about how he hopes that by establishing a class fund will inspire others to do so as their 50th reunion is being planned.

Both Barry and Stephen are still very active in their class funds. The CEF reports twice a year on the growth of the fund, and in turn they connect with their classmates about the legacy the funds are leaving to the students of the Cloquet Schools.

The children of Gordy and Jackie Nelson have selected the Cloquet Educational Foundation to honor their parents with a new endowed fund, The Gordy and Jackie Nelson Memorial Fund. Gordy passed away in 2010, and Jackie passed away in 2019.

Adding to the 27 additional endowed funds, The Gordy and Jackie Memorial fund will continue the life-long mission of Gordy and Jackie Nelson as champions of education, supporters of children and committed members of their community.

Both graduates of Roosevelt High School in Minneapolis, Gordy and Jackie were married in 1956 and began their life together in service to others as teachers. Gordy retired from the Cloquet School district in 1990 after teaching English and Spanish for 33 years, impacting several generations of Cloquet students with his easy smile and mastering of the English and Spanish language. Many will remember Jackie as easy to talk to as well as a good listener. She was kind-hearted and a strong volunteer in areas that guided children. They enjoyed spending time together as life revolved around their children Beth, Paul, and Jennifer. Their combined support of community through their church, musical events, and social circles (playing bridge) enriched them and those around them. Later, their interests took them "south of the border", where they worked passionately at the Casa Hogar Children's Home in Oaxaca, Mexico.

The Gordy and Jackie Nelson Memorial Fund will serve as a reminder of the commitment they had to quality education, support of community, and empowering children through learning. Their son Paul remembers them as, "truly remarkable people. They provided us with sound faith, guidance, and inspiration to try all we can to be good people and helpful partners in our community."
